A nurture group is a school-based intervention run by school staff with up to twelve pupils. The aim of nurture is to support pupils in developing social and emotional skills by revisiting early year's experiences. This will support them in developing positive relationships with both teachers and peers in a supportive environment. Effective nurture group practice follows the six principles of nurture.

The nurturing approach offers a range of opportunities for children and young people to develop their social and emotional skills so that they do well at school and with peers, develop their resilience and their capacity to deal more confidently with the trials and tribulations of life, for life.
