Attendance

Parking



Thank you to parents and carers who are following the guidance issued by the school via the app about our school car park. For clarity —

- 1. Parents/carers can use the car park to drop children off to breakfast club between 8.15am and 8.30am.
- 2. All parents/carers <u>must park and stride</u> when dropping off children for breakfast club or to school from <u>8.30am and 9am</u>. The school car park must be kept clear within these times for the school bus, disability taxis and out of school care drop off.
- 3. <u>Please park and stride when collecting children at 3pm</u>. The car park can only facilitate the disabled badge holders for children who attend the school. The bus must be permitted to leave the school car park before any other cars on the school grounds. This is a health and safety matter.
- 4. Please follow this guidance even if the gate does not have a member of staff. We are working hard to keep everyone safe. Staff absence or scheduled meetings means at times Mrs Hawthorn is unable to attend to the gate. I urge all community members to please work with the school to keep the grounds as safe as possible.
