It can be about places, animals, countries, trees, people...

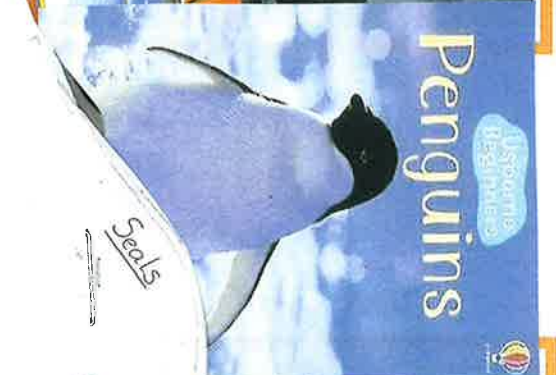
After we read we always do a task in our jokers. Sometimes we sit with Mrs S so she can help us.

Non-fiction books have sub headings. This is like a head-line but under the main title.

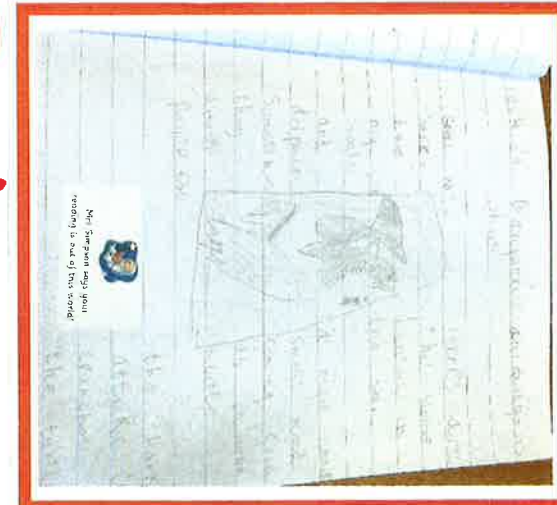


I read one about earth - quakes.
