## Breakfast Club

A gentle reminder that our school breakfast club is available from 8.15am - 8.45am. The children have a choice of cereal, toast, fruit and a drink. Any children who attend within these hours remain in the hall with Mrs L (unless they are senior pupils who have written parent/carer permission to play in the playground after they have eaten). No breakfast orders can be accommodated after 8.45am.

#### Nut Free Zone

We have many children and staff members with severe allergies. Some pupils have been bringing snacks to school that contain nuts. Please avoid such snacks, we want everyone to attend school safely.

#### Financial Inclusion Team

The Financial Inclusion Team help North Lanarkshire residents with money advice and welfare benefits. The team includes a combination of debt advisers and welfare rights staff. If you are worried about debt or experiencing financial difficulties, the debt advisers can provide free, impartial and confidential advice. ## Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Care

Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Care are a registered charity, working since March 2016, with the aim of helping families in our community. They provide two services in our local area — a school uniform bank and a Baby bank, both of which support children of all ages.
