Sometimes these groups do the same thing. Sometimes it's different activities and teaching with Mrs W.

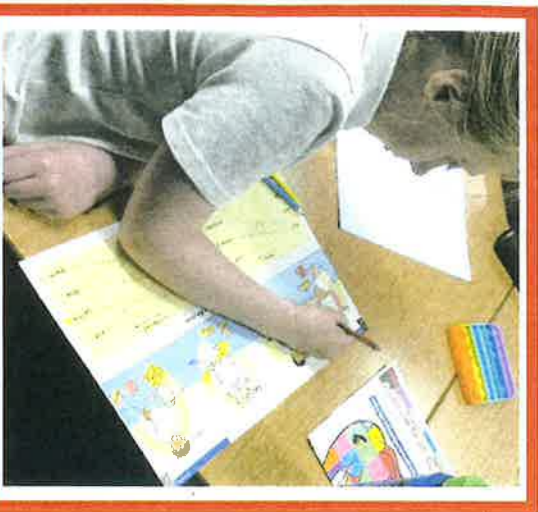


We used Splash Learn to practise. Mrs W sets us a task on Splash Learn. You need to do this task first before you do the games!
I like using Splash Learn because it is more interesting.

We used the loopy beads to make patterns with shapes and colours.

We get to work with our friends to do tasks like the matching patterns game.

Mrs W gives me a book to do tasks in. Then she checks it when I'm done.



Green in our jottar means good, you got it right.

Groups can change, it depends what we are learning.
There is a difference in the work and jottar tasks. Mrs W helps all of the groups.



A pattern repeats. It could just repeat a few times or it could be infinite, this means it doesn't stop.

Mrs W mostly marks our work. Sometimes we mark a partner's.

We make up maths questions for a friend and then we mark them.

If you have a pink dot you need to fix something.

Mrs W. will write a message so we know if we need to fix it.

This is our task-board. Mrs W always goes over this so we know what we are doing. She leaves it on the board. We can look at this if we forget what to do. We are independent! ☺



We always have a mix of things to do. We do games, board tasks and teacher time.

I think playing the games is a good idea. I'm always happy to do a board task though. I don't like textbooks. They are difficult to follow and understand. Sometimes it is good to check the answers and fix mistakes.
