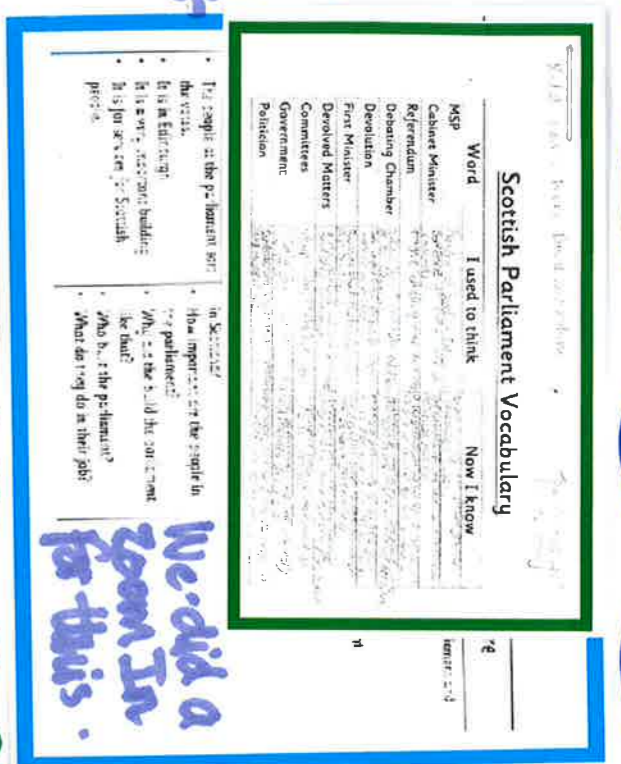

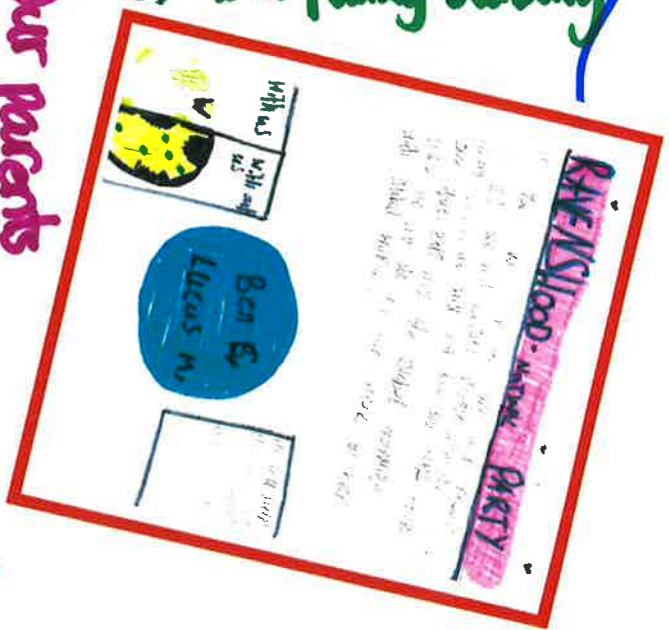
You have to be FUN!

Someone from the Scottish Parliament came to visit us. We listened to speeches from parties and had to vote for one to represent us.

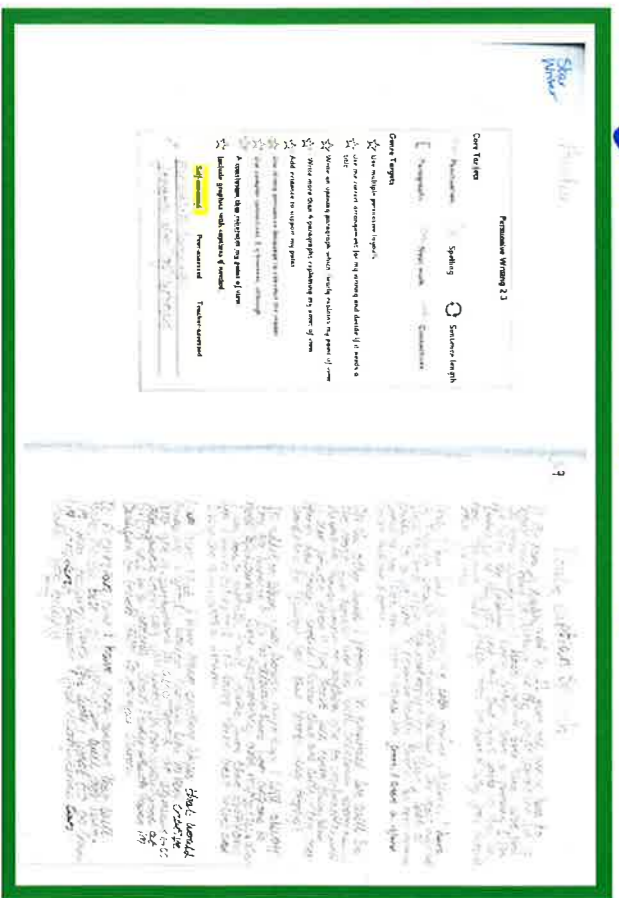


SP. is in Edinburgh.

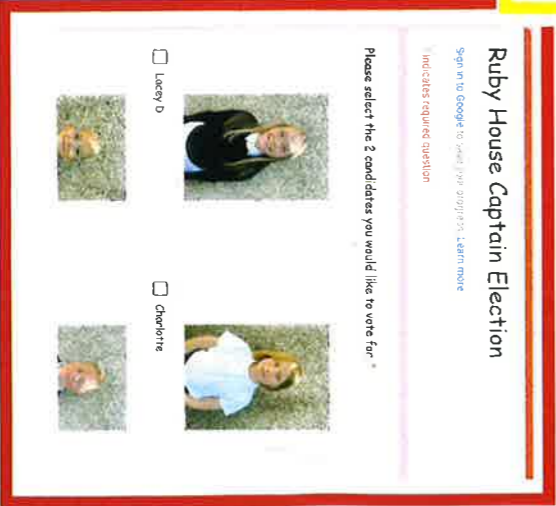
