Absence Procedures

- If your child is unwell please contact the school office as early as possible. We have an answer machine that you can leave a message on if the time of your call is outwith school hours.
- On their return to school your child should bring a letter, or you may email, detailing the reason for absence.
- If attendance at school falls below 92% we will contact you to see if we can offer any support to improve this.
- If absence rates continue to be high we may make home visits and in the most serious cases, refer to the Family Liaison Team.


