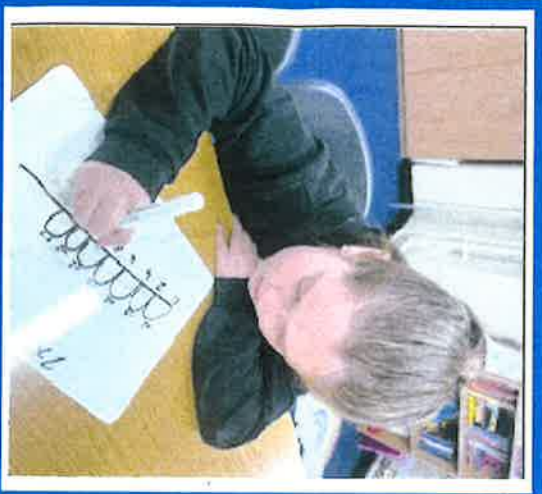
We likes!



We played Snakes and Ladders, we had to work out times table sums. We do

maths games in pairs or trios. Sometimes we do a pencil task and sometimes we do games. We do Splash Learn too. We like doing a mix of things.

When you x10 you just add a zero. You have to move all the numbers along a space.



Maths - Multiplication

We learned about arrays. 3 x 4 - you would do 3 lines of 4 dots and then 3 lines of 4 dots and then you can count and get the answer. I like this strategy.



I use my fingers and my table facts.

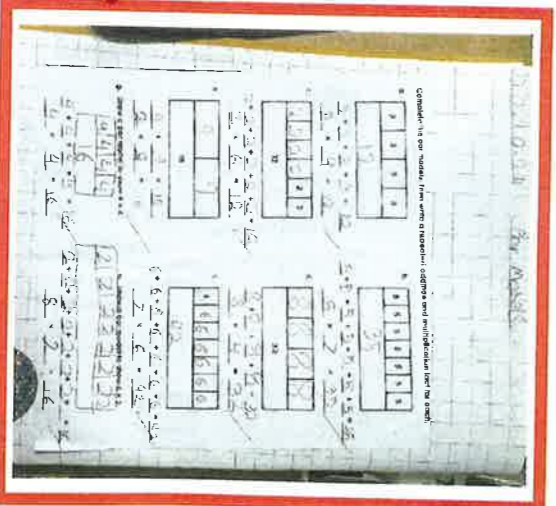
I do maths with Mrs McK, we practise lots of maths. I got a head start on division which made me more confident. I can use a number line to work out X sums. If it is x7 I need to add 7 every jump. This was tricky at first but now I know how to do it!

For bigger sums you can use a column sum.



For 9 you can use your hands. Such a cool trick!

We played times table bingo. Mrs F would give us a multiplication sum and we have to cross off the answer. It was fun, it helps me remember facts. 11 x 4 = 44



- 6 x 6 = 36
- 20 x 10 = 200
- 100 x 30 = 300
- 40 x 10 = 400
- 10 x 10 = 100

We learned about bar models. You break down the sum into different bits and add them together.
