


We used the iPad to make a 3D Roman vase. It gave us a picture and we had to copy it. It was about each thing and explained how it was hard!


Mrs Streager told us about each thing and explained how they were used. Romans came from Rome. They went all over the world, even Scotland. They were trying to get more land!

We did a taste of Roman food. Breadsticks, cheese, meat and grapes. This is what they ate.




This was the poor food.
