Mrs Stregar had a mystery Roman bag.

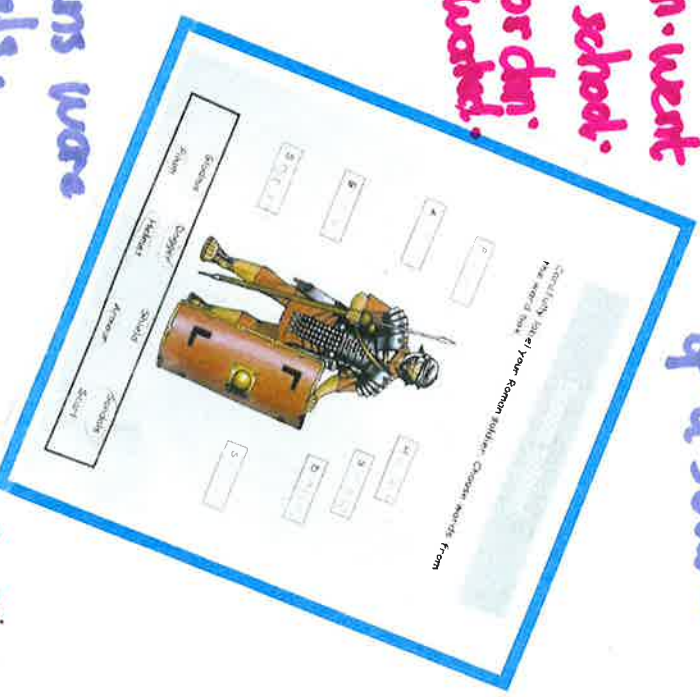
They got better food too. Slaves walked lots.
