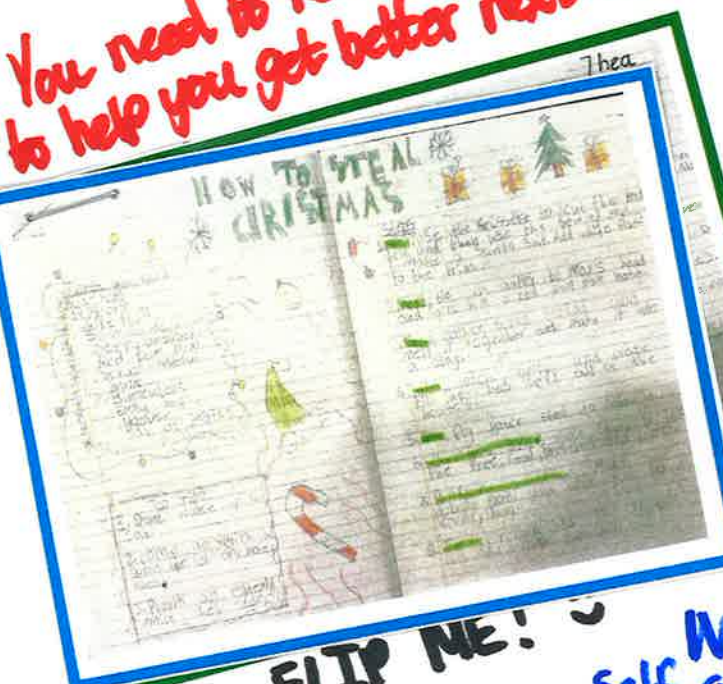

You need to have steps, they have to be in the right order. The steps tell you what to do.

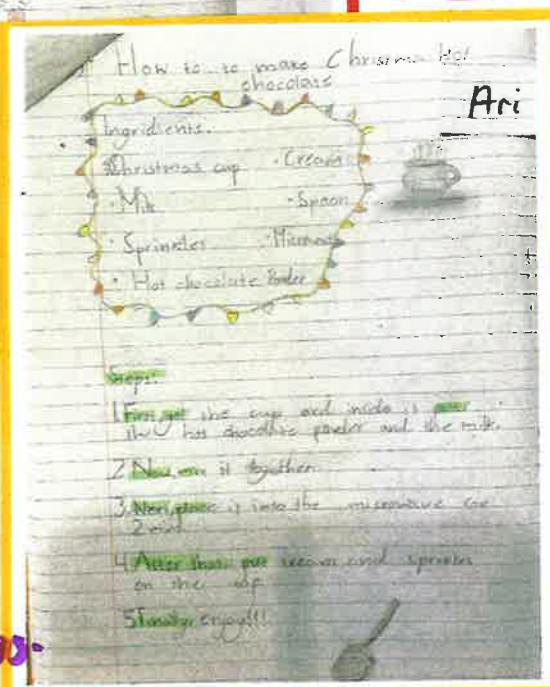
I like when my teacher marks my work because they give better comments and it's accurate.

You need to read the comment to help you get better next time.

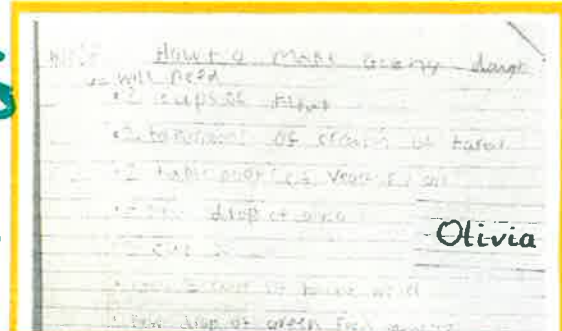

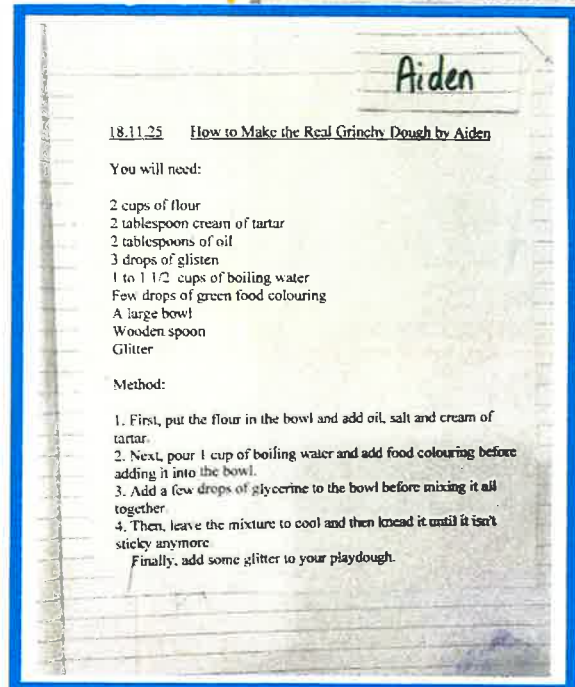

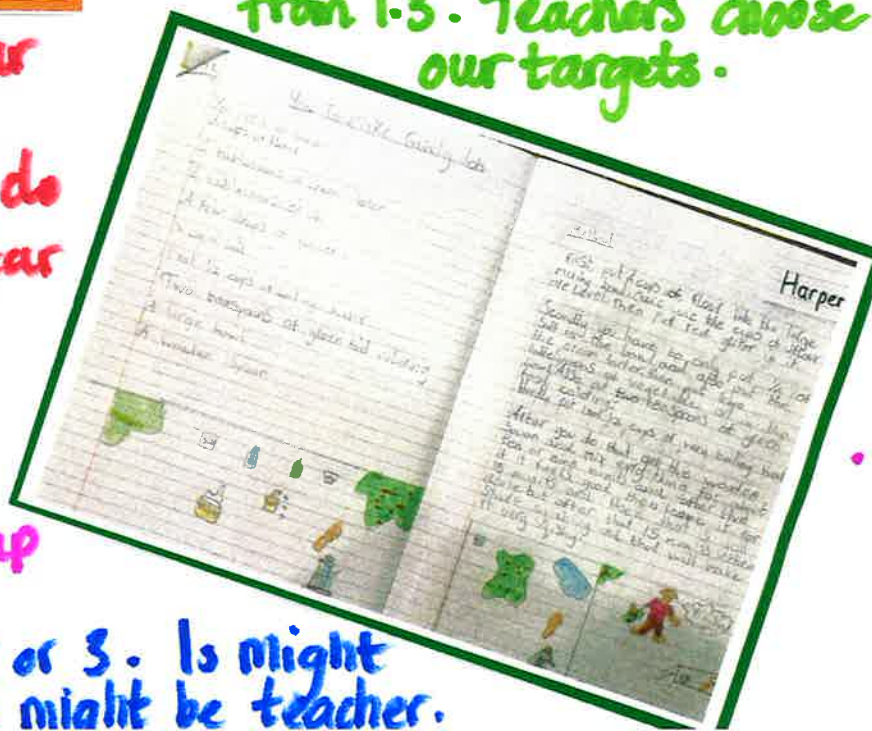
