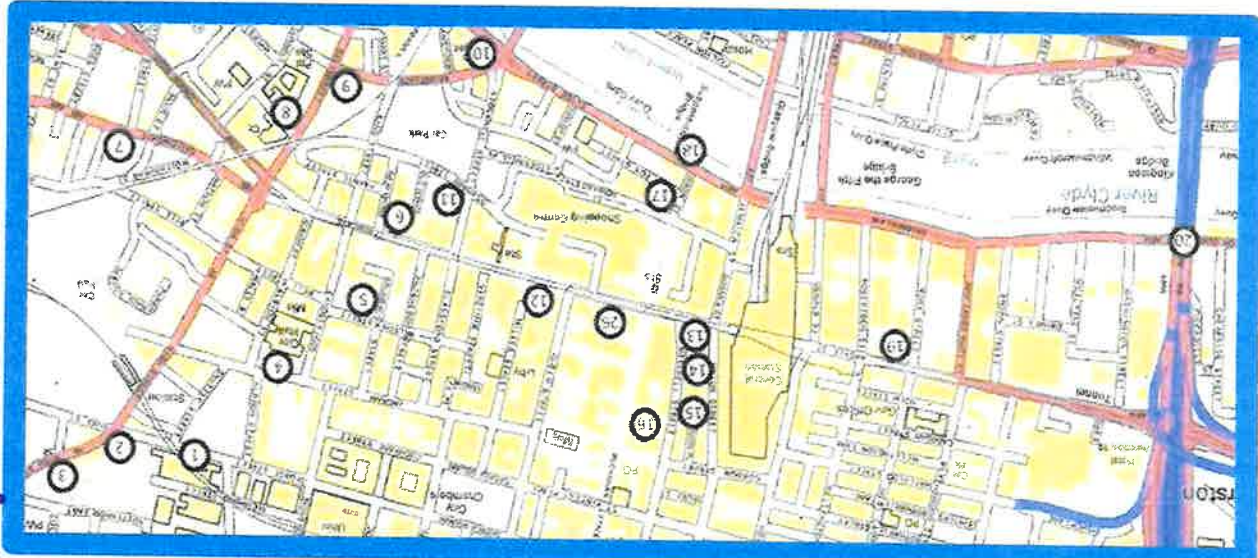
Our Topic: Scottish Street Art.

Gillian Kyle makes things that are printed with Scottish things. She went to the

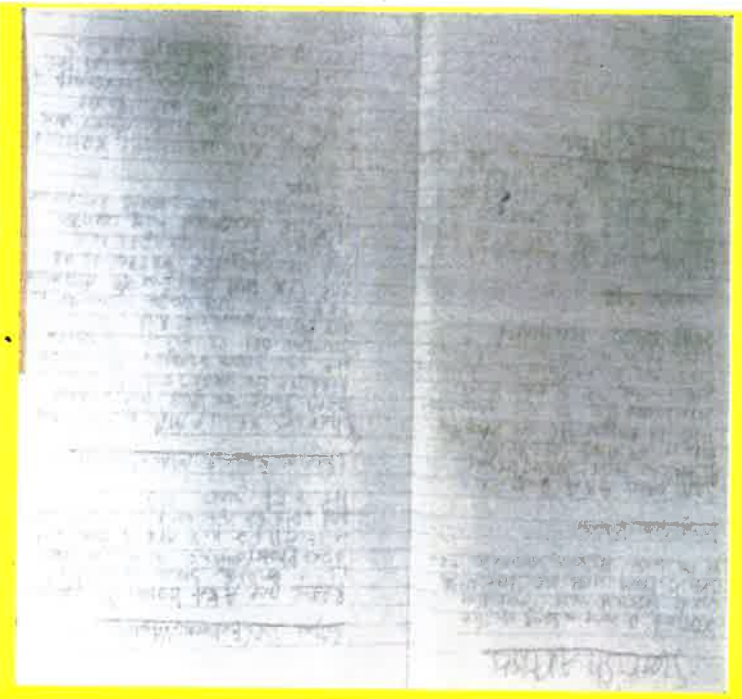


Some of the artists are alive, others are not.
