# Activity 1 – Talking and Listening

# Activity 3 – ‘Missing’ Poster

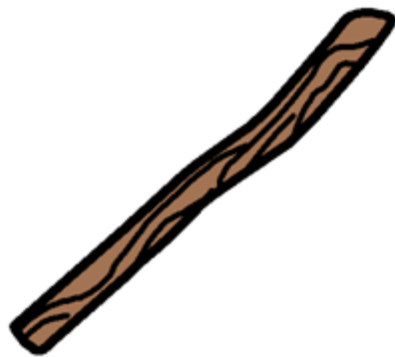
