

Activity 1 – Talking and Listening

I am learning to watch, listen and engage with a story. LIT 0-01b/LIT 0-11b

Click on the picture to watch the animation of The Gruffalo.

When it is finished talk to your child about the characters in the story.



Activity 2 – Rhyme

I am learning to use action and rhyme to join in with the story. LIT 0-01a/LIT 0-11a/LIT 0-20a

Click on the picture to listen to the story of The Gruffalo.

Encourage your child to join in with the rhyming words in the story.

Can you think of an action to go with them?



Activity 3 – Character Description

Ask your child to draw a picture of the Gruffalo. Encourage them to include as much detail as possible. Discuss and describe each part of the the Gruffalo's body.
