Therapet

 Following a request made from one of Captains in their presentation, we have arranged a Therapet dog to visit the school over a few weeks beginning at the end of November. The French Bulldog will support children who may be reluctant readers for a variety of reasons.

Dogs Trust

 We had a visit last week from someone from the Dogs Trust, who visited all the classes to run a workshop on caring for dogs in their home and in the community.

Counselling/Play Therapy

 We are pleased to be able to offer a one-to-one counselling session to those children who require it, and this will begin in November. This is funded using money distributed from Scottish Government to local authorities for this specific purpose. We have also contributed to a cluster fund to support the running of play therapy sessions, which will begin around the start of 2024.

Pupil Leadership Groups

Aim High Team

 We have now appointed our new school captains – Ryan and Grace. Our Aim High Team have had their first meetings and are beginning to plan for Book Week and Anti-Bullying week in November (week beginning 13th November).
 5 members of our Aim High Team will also be presenting as part of a presentation about our play/enquiry work at Strathclyde University to 250 teaching students.

Rights Respecting Reps

 We are delighted to have achieved our Silver Rights Respecting school award and will soon be recruiting new class reps to continue our journey to Gold.

Fundraising Team

Our new fundraising team have had their first meetings where they created
the fundraising calendar for the year. They are beginning work on their
Halloween fundraiser, and we are also taking part in the Cauliflower Cards
'Christmas Design Project'. Both fundraisers will raise money for school funds.

<u>Eco</u>

Leadership of our Eco Committee has been taken over by Miss MacBeth. The
committee are continuing to work on our 2-year action plan with an evidence
submission due in June for our next Eco Flag. This session our focus will be
on biodiversity.

Reading Schools

 We have recently registered to become a 'Reading School'. Miss Sichi will be leading this work and is currently recruiting some children who will help her take forward the actions required.

Rotary Club

 We have recently linked with the local Rotary Club who are keen to work with the school on a variety of projects. Our first project is 'Lend with Care' which our P6 class are taking part in. The children will learn about different countries and be able to support people who need help. The club have also given us 2000 crocus corms to plant in our side playground planters.

Additional Support Needs

 New Educational Psychologist, Sophie Wardrope supporting a number of children across school and nursery

- Mrs Shields, Mrs Colquhoun and Miss Macbeth offering Support for Learning this year, with Mr Innes and Mrs Torley overseeing Support for Learning to ensure maximum impact on learners
- We are running five full Seasons for Growth groups over the course of the school year – the most we have ever had

Nursery Class

- Continued use of Learning Journals with support of Parent Council funding having a significant impact on planning, assessment and sharing the learning journey with parents
- Forest Kindergarten at approved site in Brownsburn Park established last session and continuing this session, again with Parent Council funding support
- 'Loving Lunches' in full swing where children are now enjoying lunch in the nursery class rather than the dinner hall – children are now self-serving their lunches
- Priorities for this year are to conduct more rigorous tracking and monitoring of learning, improve engagement in self-evaluation, and develop staff leadership roles

Action Point – Discussion around dates for parents diary which are in the newsletter and potentially linking that up and including the PC dates for diary. This to be further discussed.

Action Point – Flyer for Christmas fayre to be sent out in school communications after Halloween, plea for tombola items etc Fundraising
