

Hi There,

This is the 1st newsletter to keep you all updated on progress with the new Nursery Extension at your school - Shawhead Primary School.

We started on site on Saturday 8th February – the first task was to form the temporary fire escape, which you will now have to use in the event of a fire – a new ramp has been built outside to take you all into the playground. Once you have gone down the ramp you must make your way to the Assembly Point – this is in the same place as it was before. All you children must ask the teachers if you have any questions about fire escape routes as it is very important.



The Next Stage

The work taking place over the next 2 – 3 weeks involves laying the foundations for the new extension, the new concrete slab, substructure and all the underground drainage. Once the building is finished you will not see any of this work as it will be beneath the ground or hidden by the next stages of the build, however, like all things in life, even learning at school, you need to start with good foundations !!

Once this important part of the build is complete, the timber frame walls of the building will start, followed by the roof and then we start inside to form the rooms. This newsletter will keep you posted as the extension progresses. below are a couple of photos of the foundations, made from concrete. Once we have the walls up, you will be able to see better the size of the extension.
