### **The Next Stage**

The work taking place over the next 4 weeks will be internal, forming the rooms and insulating the building to keep you all warm. Brickwork will start to go up on the outside of the walls and the doors and windows will be put into place.

### **Traffic on Site.**

As mentioned in all the previous newsletters, we'd like to thank everyone, children, parents and teachers, for keeping to the playground area and away from the building site. As well as workmen getting on with their jobs, excavators and dumpers moving around, we also have deliveries coming through the gates and it can be extremely dangerous.

### **The Dangers of Building Sites.**

Since the last update, due to the ongoing problems with children causing damage to the site, we have installed CCTV cameras to the site compound to prevent any unauthorised access. These cameras are linked to a security hub and when anyone tries to enter the site the images are captured, and notification is sent to the police and security guards. The police already have several images of children and have been called out on a couple of occasions. After speaking to the local residents, we also know who some of the culprits are. Things seem to have improved, but we would ask all parents to be vigilant at this time of year as the temptation to light fires and set off fireworks could cause even more damage to the new extension.
