1	PRAISE AND FOCUS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Praise positive behaviour. • Sit me in the best area to focus. • Use strategies that help me learn.
2	EXPECTED BEHAVIOUR		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reinforce and explain expected behaviour to me. • Go over visuals with me.
3	REMINDER		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remind me about expectations and good choices. • Remind me that I have the right to learn and so do others in my class.
4	CALM TIME		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If needed, I will be supported to choose an area that will help me to manage my feeling and emotions. This may be in the classroom calm area, the STAR room or the sensory den.
5	REPORTED, RECORDED AND RESTORED		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A member of the Senior Leadership Team will now talk with me about my behaviour and record this. • I will be supported to show expected behaviours in and around school. • I understand that there will be consequence for my behaviour. • I will be supported to repair and restore my relationships and improve my behaviour.

At Shawhead Primary and Nursery Class, we believe that happy children learn best. Our school is a place where everyone is treated with kindness, respect, and fairness. We work together to help children feel safe, included, and ready to learn.

This guide will allow all adults at Shawhead to support our children to:

- Build positive relationships with others
- Make good choices
- Learn in a safe and caring environment

Rights Respecting Approach

At Shawhead Primary, we teach children that **everyone has rights**—these are things every child is entitled to, just for being a child. These rights:

- Belong to **every child**, everywhere in the world.
- **Can't be taken away**, no matter what.
- Don't depend on how someone behaves—they're always there.

We also help children understand that while they enjoy their own rights, it's important to **respect the rights of others** too. This means being kind, fair, and thoughtful in how we treat each other.



What We Promise Each Other

- Respect ourselves – so we feel proud and ready to learn
- Respect others – so everyone feels safe and included
- Respect property – so we can enjoy our school and its resources



What Adults Do to Help

- Are kind, fair, and patient
- Listen and help when children feel upset or angry
- Plan fun and engaging lessons
- Encourage children to do their best
- Help children learn how to fix problems and make things right



What We Expect from Children

- Be respectful and kind to everyone
- Include others and be a good friend
- Look after school property
- Try their best in learning
- Use calming strategies when upset (like visiting the Calm Corner)
- Speak to an adult if they need help



What Happens When Things Go Wrong

Sometimes children make mistakes – and that's okay. We help them to:

- Take responsibility
- Repair relationships
- Return to learning

Consequences may include:

- Time in the STAR room (a calm space to reset)
- Moving seats or working alone for a short time to refocus
- Talking with a teacher or member of the leadership team
- Losing a privilege
- A phone call home
- Being placed on a Kindness Chart



Restorative Conversations

We use restorative approaches to help children reflect and make things better.

We will support our children to discuss:

- What happened?
- How did it make others feel?
- What can you do to fix it?
