At Shawhead Primary School and Nursery, we want every child to take part in school life without money ever being a barrier. We understand that families can face financial pressures, and we are here to help—confidentially, respectfully, and without judgement.

## School Trips & Outings

All school trips are **subsidised** to keep costs low.

Families receive **plenty of notice** and can **pay in small instalments**.

If you're finding it difficult, please speak to us privately—support is available.

P7 Outward Bound costs can be supported through school funds or the Parent Council, so **no child misses out**.

## Travel to School

Most children walk, cycle, or scoot.

Families are encouraged to apply for **free Under-22 bus travel**.

## Clubs & Activities

All after-school clubs run by staff are **free of charge**. We want every child to enjoy activities that build confidence, friendships, and new skills.

## School Uniform Support

Our uniform is simple and affordable:

- White shirt or polo
- Black trousers or skirt
- School sweatshirt, navy jumper, or cardigan
- Branded items are optional. Similar clothing can be bought from local supermarkets.

We also offer:

- Pre-loved uniform donations
- Winter jackets, waterproofs, wellies and gloves (especially in Nursery)
- Halloween costume & Christmas jumper recycle banks
- Minimal dress-down days to reduce pressure

## Meals & Food Support

- **Breakfast Club** is free for all P1–5 pupils and for P6–7 pupils who receive free school meals.
- **Club 365** offers free meals and activities at weekends and during holidays.
