Interdisciplinary Study

The topic for this term will be 'Local Environment,' The children will participate in class discussions, activities and outdoor walks. This topic will enable the children to develop a greater understanding of the area they live in. They will be investigating and exploring the past- what the area used to look like (iron works,etc), present-what the area is like today (shops, housing, etc) and future developments for the area (new school). Please talk to your child about where they live. Maybe discuss what it was like when their Gran/Grandad was young.

Literacy

All of the children are making good progress and in all areas of literacy. The children have built up a vocabulary of words and sounds and are learning to use them to help them both with their reading and writing. They are blending these letter sounds together to create words and write sentences and are becoming more confident every day. The children will continue to build their vocabulary and I will send home the new common words to reinforce their learning at home.

Numeracy

We will continue with our class maths challenge as it is proving to be a great success with the children keen to participate.
