Welcome back to the last term, how time flies! I hope you enjoyed the Easter break and are ready for the final term. Here is an overview of what we will be doing in the new term and how we will be preparing for our move to Riverbank Primary School after the summer, exciting times ahead!

Interdisciplinary Study

As we say goodbye to Sikeside we will be learning about a decade in the past. Primary 4 are going to explore the 1980s, we will be researching TV/film, music, popular toys, technological inventions and important historical events.

Literacy

In literacy P4 will be continuing to work on the North Lanarkshire Council Active Literacy Programme, which involves exploring phoneme knowledge, building vocabulary and common word spelling strategies. We will be reading for enjoyment and beginning our new reading books and novel studies, reading with a partner, giving feedback and focussing on our reading strategies. Our main genre for writing this term is **Explanation** and we will be revising all other genres too, using our Interdisciplinary Learning and our environment as a stimulus. We will be continuing with our class novel Matilda.

We will be continuing with our daily Number Talks, sharing our mental maths strategies during class discussions, and using Sumdog to practise maths skills.
