# **IMPORTANT NEWS**

As you will be aware, schools are now operating under "The New Normal".

Please read the following information very carefully so that you are up to date with our new procedures and protocols.

Parents are NOT permitted to enter the school buildings (P4-P7 parents are currently permitted into the yard at home times only during the on-going construction works – these parents are asked to wait, socially distanced in the red holding zone).

Parents are required to telephone the school if they wish to speak to a member of the SMT as unfortunately you are not permitted to visit the school at this time.

- Breakfast Club 8.15 start. Please remind you child to sanitise their hands when entering for breakfast club.
- Day Cleaner we currently have a day cleaner within the school as an enhanced safety measure. The day cleaner will wipe down desks and touch points. Your child will be washing and sanitising regularly throughout the day.
- Cashless In response to the current Covid-19 crisis it has been decided that where possible cash should be removed from schools. For the last 3 years we have been encouraging parents/carers to sign up to utilise the IpayImpact online system. Our new pupils will receive their information letter later this week.
- Out of School Hours Learning these are paused for the time being.
- Choir this is paused for the time being.
- Assemblies as you will be aware Miss Love and Mr Duffy would normally have an assembly every Friday morning however, we are not permitted to do so at present.
- Social distancing the latest scientific advice from the Scottish Government is that there is no requirement for Primary aged pupils to socially distance. All school staff however, should maintain a 2 metre distance between themselves and other adults and where possible the pupils
- Outdoor Play We plan to deliver more outdoor learning as medical guidance tells us that the risk of transmission of the virus is significantly less when outdoors. PE is currently not permitted to take place within the school therefore you will be asked to send your child dressed suitably for PE (weather dependent) here is a suggested list:-
  - (1) Outdoor trainers
  - (2) Shorts and T-Shirt (sunny weather)

(3) Jogging trousers and sweatshirt/hoodies (cooler weather)

(4) Waterproof jacket (rainy weather)

 Resources - children can bring their own school bag with lunch and snacks from home. Mrs Brown has been really busy organising a pencil case for every child in the school to ensure that resources are not being shared. Every child has their own tray containing their own learning equipment. Pupils will be able to take reading books and homework resources home. During this time we will use two jotters only - 1 language and 1 maths. Ventilation - where possible we will ensure that doors and windows are kept open to ensure that natural flow of ventilation and to reduce unnecessary

NO games or toys to be brought into school from home.

# School Uniform

Could I please remind you to LABEL your child's clothes. We already have missing jumpers and children have taken home the wrong items of clothing. Please ensure that all items including clothing, footwear, bags and packed lunch boxes/bags are labelled with your child's name.



#### Indoor Shoes

Children are required to change into suitable indoor footwear. Plimsolls are preferable. Indoor shoes that no longer fit or "past their best" will be sent home to let parents know they are no longer suitable.

#### <u>Communication</u>

It is vitally important that we have clear and effective communication systems with parents.

#### <u>Good to Be Green</u>

The current Good to Be Green behaviour system is currently paused as we are not permitted to send home the weekly behaviour cards.

We will however, continue to promote positive behaviour within every class.

Last week the children made their class charter and rules based on our "New Normal" and Covid Procedures.

If your child is not following the class rules you will be contacted by a member of the Management Team.

Please chat with your children about their classroom rules and encourage them to follow them. We really appreciate your co-operation in this matter.

## <u>Water Bottles</u>

We encourage children to bring a water bottle to school each day to keep them hydrated during lessons. Please note that **<u>only</u>** water is permitted.



Children should take them home each night to be washed. It is recommended that bottles be 'BPA Free' and that they are washed with soapy water each night.

The re-use of disposable water bottles is not recommended.

Children can bring metal water bottles or flasks but glass bottles are not permitted.

# Fizzy Drinks

Cans/bottles of carbonated drinks, including energy drinks are **NOT** permitted.

# Mobile Phones / Electronic Devices

Please ensure your child does **<u>NOT</u>** bring their mobile phones to school.

If you need to be in contact with your child in the course of the school day for any reason, you should proceed through the usual channel, which is through the school office. We are always very happy to pass on a message or let your child know of any unexpected change of arrangements for home time.

## Sickness and Diahorrea



Please note that children experiencing these symptoms should not return to school for **48 hours** following the last period of sickness/diahorrea

# COVID-19 - NHS Guidelines

Symptoms - the main symptoms are:-

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense or smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

## What to do if your child has symptoms

If your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:

- Get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible
- Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get your test result only leave your home to have the test.
- Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get the result.

# GENERAL NEWS

#### Nut Free Zone

Within St Margaret of Scotland Primary School we have several children who are extremely allergic to any kind of nuts, so I would ask you to be particularly vigilant with snacks and packed lunches.

#### Head lice

Be extra vigilant and check your child's hair regularly.

#### Make Up /Nail Varnish

Please be aware that the wearing of nail varnish to school is not encouraged.

The wearing of 'make up' is NOT permitted. Any child wearing 'make up' to school will be asked to remove it immediately.

#### Jewellery

For reasons of health and safety jewellery should **not** be worn to school.

For those children with ears pierced, please note that small studs only are permitted. Children will be asked to remove all other jewellery.

NB. Stud earrings should be removed on PE days and in the case of recently pierced ears then these should be covered with tape.
