Our Nursery Graduations will take place on Friday 23^{rd} June 2023. More details will follow nearer the time.




Nut Free Zone

Within St Margaret of Scotland Primary School we have several children who are extremely allergic to any kind of nuts, so I would ask you to be particularly vigilant with snacks and packed lunches.



Make Up /Nail Varnish

Please be aware that the wearing of nail varnish to school is not encouraged.





The wearing of "make up" is NOT permitted. Any child wearing "make up" to school will be asked to remove it immediately.

Jewellery

For reasons of health and safety jewellery should **not** be worn to school.

For those children with their ears pierced, small studs only are permitted. Children will be asked to remove all other jewellery.

NB. Stud earrings should be removed on PE days and in the case of recently pierced ears then these should be covered with tape.
