Trip to the Active Kids Adventure park

If you are late the buses will have to leave without you. All children must have an adult accompanying them on the trip. The buses will return for 2.45pm to allow school children to be picked up on time.

Inservice Day 8th June

As our school is a voting school we will be closed to children on the 8th June 2017 because of the general election.

Sports Day

The morning sports day will run between 9.30am and 10.30am and the afternoon sports day will be from 1.45pm until 2.45pm. Please ensure your child is dressed in suitable clothing and footwear on this day to allow them to take part in the races. This event will be weather dependant.

Graduation

We will be holding our pre-school graduation on Monday 26th June for all children who will be starting school in August. Tea will be served from 10am on this day and we will require parents to volunteer to supervise the tea and coffee as staff will be with the children at this time. Parents of children who are attending should be seated for 10.30am. All children who are **attending school in August should attend nursery in the morning** on this day and all other children (**Anti - pre school**) should come to nursery in the **afternoon on this day**.

The nursery will close on Tuesday 27th June 2017 (See separate letter). Sessions will run as normal on this day. This will be our final party and day of the nursery year.
