Numeracy and Maths

Our focus for this term will be:

Number Talks

Estimating and Rounding

Addition and Subtraction.



Mathematics and its impact on the world; past, present and future.

2D and 3D shapes and objects.

The children will be learning:

- To talk about the strategies used to solve number operations and check if an answer is reasonable.
- That numbers are part of everyday life. We will look at the history of numbers.
- To round up or down to whole numbers within 100.
- Add and subtract within 100 using horizontal and vertical methods.
- To make links when dividing and multiplying focusing on the 2, 4, 5 and 10 times tables.

Our focus for this term is: Nurtured

The children will be learning:

- To develop strategies to deal with some of the challenges of friendships and relationships.
- To know that family and friends are important to our health and wellbeing.



Physical Education
