Numeracy and Maths



This term we will be learning:

To talk about the different ways to solve a problem.

To recognise all coins to £2 and to make combinations of totals using a range of coins to £1.

To use addition and subtraction skills to work out change within £1, then beyond.



To develop confidence in times tables. (2, 4, 5 and 10)

To split items into a number of equal parts. ($\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{5}$)

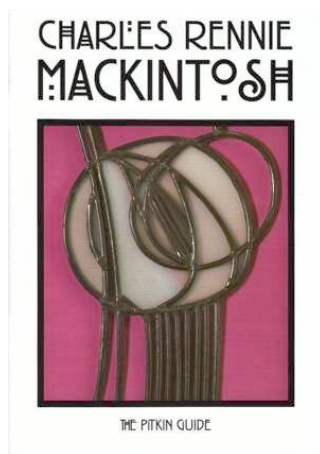
January -April Primary 3
