### Christmas Fundraising

Huge thanks to you all we managed to raise £633 from our Christmas shows which will go towards our outdoor learning activities and resources. In addition we made £187 from our Christmas fun day, this helped to pay for the juice and snacks at the Christmas parties. Our P6's and P7's did a tremendous job singing at the town centre and collectively raised £419 for charity. Most of this money will go to St Nicholas's Care Fund who support local children who live in poverty in the West of Scotland. The children will be consulted about what we do with the remainder. We also raised £124 for Save The Children from our Christmas jumper day. I'm sure you will agree that this is a tremendous achievement and we are very grateful for all of your support.

We take a register at the start of the clubs, if your child is not attending on any of the days or has given the club up please contact the school office ASAP. ### REMINDERS

**Absence** - Please remember if your child is absent from school to call the office on the first day.

Sickness/Tummy Bugs – Children should not return until 48hours clear due to passing on the infection.

**Gym Days** – **No** jewellery to be worn on gym days, all earrings must be taped up are home or removed prior to coming to school.

**School Ties** – Available from the school office - £4 each.
