### **Primary 1**



**Our Writing will be linked to children's personal experiences.**

**Our focus for Writing activities will be:**

- \* **Narrative**
- ◆ **Posters**
- ◆ **Letter writing**

**Our focus for Reading will be:**

- **To use knowledge of sounds to help read new and unfamiliar words.**
- **To find information in the text to support their answers.**



**Our focus for Talking and Listening will be:**

- \* **To answer simple questions and make predictions.**
- \* **To take turns when talking and listening in a variety of contexts.**

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**Our focus for this term is: Addition and Subtraction**

**The children will be learning to :**

- ♦ **Count on and count back from any given number up to 30.**
- ♦ **Add simple amounts in their head.**
- ♦ **Add doubles up to 5 mentally.**
- ♦ **Recognise number words up to 10.**
- ♦ **Subtract mentally up to 10.**
- ♦ **Record simple addition problems**
- ♦ **Record number stories up to 10**



**Our focus this term is :**

**Money, simple directions and positioning**

**The children will learn to :**

- ♦ **Name and identify coins to £2.**
- ♦ **Count with 1ps**
- ♦ **Describe a simple journey and follow someone's instructions.**
- ♦ **Describe positions using simple terms front, back, above, below etc.**



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## **Health and Wellbeing**

**Our focus for this term is: Being Active and Food**

**Children will**

- **Explore ways to be active and give our bodies lots of exercise.**
- **Identify the activities we enjoy that are not active.**
- **Investigate food from around the world and taste some simple dishes.**
