Literacy

In Primary 6 we will carry out different Literacy tasks with both of our Class Teachers Mrs Yuill and Mrs McPhilemy.

Our focus for writing activities:

- Persuasive- create a descriptive piece of writing that persuades the reader to make a judgement about our character
- Discursive – linked to our IDL topic of New Technologies- Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of Technologies through the centuries
- Narrative Writing – exploring different stimulus for writing creative stories

Our focus for reading activities

- Identifying and creating visualisation
- Creating character/setting descriptions
- Answering and creating comprehension questions

Our focus for Talking and Listening activities will be:

- Developing skills in sharing and turn taking when responding in pair, small group and whole class feedback situations.
- Deliver a partner talk on New Technologies

Numeracy and Maths

In Primary 6 we will carry out different Numeracy and Maths tasks with both of our Class Teachers Mrs Weir and Mrs McPhilemy.

In Mathematics skills we will be focusing on:

- Angles- to recognise, identify and measure different types of angles
- Compass Points- using technology identify the link between angles and compass points

In Numeracy skills we will be focusing on:

Mental Agility- continue to improve multiplication and division skills
Number- explore and use negative numbers

IDL

In Primary 6 we will carry out two different IDL topics New Technologies and 2018 World Cup

- Carry out a KWL to find out what pupils already KNOW about New Technologies ask pupils what they WANT to know about New Technologies and discover ways in which pupils will LEARN about New Technologies. Pupils' prior knowledge and their ideas will be incorporated into their learning.
- To investigate how inventions such as transport, communication, devices and medicine have change through the years.
- To discuss the changes and improvements.
- To create a timeline of important events
- To create a PowerPoint of facts.

We will be investigating the topic of 2018 World Cup:

- Explore countries taking part in World Cup
- Use mapping skills to plot them on a map
- Investigate the respecting rights of some countries
- Use football to examine equality/ inequality between and within countries,
- explore footballers and other people who have taken action to make the world fairer,
- investigate how making new rules in football could make the game fairer
