Numeracy and Maths


Our focus for this term will be:

Multiplying and Dividing by 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10.

Patterns and Relationships



The children will be learning to:

- Recall many multiplication facts from memory and use these to calculate the answers which they don't recall, e.g. 21 + 3= How many 3s are in 21? 3 what's are 21?
- Read Times in digital and analogue including o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.
- Calculate simple time intervals by counting on, e.g. The cake needs to bake for 20 minutes. If it goes into the oven at 5 past 10, at what time will it be ready?
- Record measurements using standard abbreviations, e.g. cm, m, g, kg, l, ml
- Solve simple problems by identifying and applying basic rules



Focus for Learning April- June Primary 3

Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be looking at Included within aspects of Food and Health. We will be learning that eating together is an important time to interact with others

Working together with your child at home is a very valuable part of this topic. Below are some simple ideas to experience with your child.

Why do we need to have table manners? What is it about things like keeping your mouth closed when you eat that makes the experience for other people eating with you a much more enjoyable one?

Setting the table to include everyone is something your child would enjoy doing. Encourage them to have a go making it as elaborate as they want to eg place cards for where to sit, a menu, glasses for different drinks.

Think about all the places you go to eat outside your home and how often you do this. Discuss all the different locations where you and your child go to eat and the kind of foods you enjoy there eg an ice-cream at Soave's
