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Numeracy and Maths

Our focus for this term is:

- Place value with focus on zero as a place holder
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division revision
- Weight and Volume

The children will be learning to :

- Complete calculations using zero as a placeholder where there are no hundreds, tens or units but there are thousands.
- Arrange numbers up to 9,999 in ascending and descending order
- Write numbers up to 9,999 in digits and words
- Use appropriate instruments and units of measure including millilitres, litres, grams and kilograms.
- Multiply and divide a 2 or 3 digit number
