Our focus for this term is: Number and Time

- Count on and count back from any given number, P2 up to 100
- Understand the value of a number.
- Recognise small number of objects without counting.
- Make or draw collections of a given size.
- Match quantities and numerals.
- Round numbers to the nearest 10.
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- The terms o'clock, half past, quarter to (p2) and quarter past (p2)
- Read digital clock and analogue clocks using terms taught.
- Convert digital to analogue and vice versa.
- The days of the week, months of the year and the seasons.
- Number bonds to 10.
