It is very important that you do not allow your child to bring in any food to the nursery.



Safety

Could we remind all parents/carers to pay particular attention when opening and closing the door. Please help to ensure the safety of all children by allowing only those directly in your care to leave and always close the door firmly behind you by lifting the handle to ensure it is locked. Please ensure that gates leaving the nursery and school grounds are closed to ensure the safety of both Nursery and School children.

If you are in the cloakroom and the doorbell rings please alert a member of staff. Please do not allow the children to open or close the gate.

Child unwell

Can we please remind all parents to keep their children off nursery when unwell. This is hugely important for infection control as I'm sure you will all understand colds/bugs spread very quickly between all the children which can then pass onto staff. If you have any questions regarding length of time your child should remain off nursery with an illness please do not hesitate to phone the nursery for advice but there is also a large information sheet in the hall with exclusion/incubation times for a range of illnesses.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We would like to remind parents that children should not open the nursery gate under any circumstances. The hinge on the gate allows it to move both ways which has resulted in head injuries in the past Staff have noticed that some children are being allowed to open the gate on a regular basis and we would ask parents to explain to their children the reasons why they should not touch it as it is for their safety.

Stay and Play/workshop Sessions

On Wednesday 10th we will be holding our first stay and play day. This will be session where parents/carers can spend some time in the nursery with their child. The morning workshop will start at 9.30am and finish at 10.00am, you are then welcome to spend some time in nursery with your child (this play session will end at 11am). The afternoon will start at 1.30pm and finish at 2.00pm (this play session will end at 3pm).

Children should attend nursery at the normal times.

Halloween Party

We will be holding our Halloween parties on Wednesday 31st October. We will have party games and prizes on this day. The children can dress up in a costume but we would ask parents to consider that not all children like masks so costumes that are not scary would be best. All children should attend their normal sessions. The party contribution list will be placed in the hall nearer the date, we would be very grateful if you could help.

Learning Journals

Most parents will be aware that we are using online learning journals within the nursery. All Parents should have received login details for this resource. If you have not received any emails about this you can speak to a member of staff who will be happy to reset the password for you. We use the learning journals to track the children's progress. It also allows parents to see what their child has been learning in the nursery. It allows comments to be added from parents also. We would ask parents to use this resource to facilitate

discussions with their child about the learning taking place in the nursery. It may remind the children what they were doing as we know some children say that they do nothing in nursery all day long \odot .

If you have this book at home we would encourage parents to continue reading the story and talking about the different characters and what happens in the story.
