## Parent's Evening

Thank you to all those parents who managed to come along and for the very positive responses to our parental feedback. The results of which are as follows:

- 64 people responded to the questionnaire.
- 5 People said they did not feel they were given guidance about how to support their child's learning.
- 3 people did not feel that the school responded well to concerns
- 2 people did not feel that pupils with additional support needs were well supported in school.

Everyone else agreed or strongly agreed with the statements, which is tremendous. It is very difficult to please everyone however if you have any ideas about how we can improve please let us know. Some of the additional comments included: 'My child loves school and I feel his confidence has come on leaps and bounds with the support of the staff.'

'Happy with both my children's education' I am very happy with my child's progress. There is a fantastic level of communication between staff and parents.

There were several other positive comments which are always wonderful for us to hear. Thank you.

#### **REMINDERS**

**Absence** - Please remember if your child is absent from school to call the office on the first day. Please do not email any member of staff as this may be missed if out of the building. Sickness/Tummy Bugs – Children should not return until

48hours clear due to passing on the infection.
