


Primary 3-4 Home Learning Activities December

<p style="text-align: center;">Read any books brought home.</p> <p>*Preview the book- Read the front cover, back cover and scan the pages to look at any pictures.</p> <p>*Visualise- Make a movie in your mind as you read! Picture;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The character's actions -The character's facial expressions - Where the characters are <p>* Ask Questions-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is going on in the story - How does this fit with what you already know - Does what I'm reading make sense? 	<p>We have been handling data in class. <p>Sounds/ Spelling- Use the lists on the website to do a spelling bee.</p> <p>Ask your child to spell the word by sounding out the letters and saying the word to show they have finished e.g. house h-o-u-s-e house. Practise any words that are incorrect until you have mastered them.</p>	<p>Continue to work on real life time durations in different ways.</p> <p>e.g. If we leave the house at 8.30am and get to school at 8.50 am how long did our journey take? If we want to get to school for 8.50am and the journey takes 10 minutes, when should we leave?</p>	<p>Continue to learn the words to the songs for our Christmas show. Our class will be elves so will be wearing red or green t-shirts. We have some in school but children can wear their own if they have them.</p>

If you have a chance to watch Christmas adverts think about; Colour and light- How does the lighting change throughout and what kind of mood does it create? Sound and Music- At what different points does the music change? What mood does this create? Storyline- What happens at the beginning? How does the story unfold?
