Adverse Weather

As you know the weather in Scotland – and especially in Cumbernauld, can be unpredictable. When it is icy underfoot the janitor must clear one path to the school. This will be the path from the front of the building to the main entrance. In addition a path to the GP room will also be cleared. Once this is complete the janitor will begin to grit other paths if it safe to do so.

Please bring your child through the GP room entrance, just before 9am and no earlier than 8.50am. Please remind your child that high standards of behaviour are expected while they wait in the classrooms before 9am.

Remember breakfast club starts at 8.15am until 8.50am at a daily cost of £1.(unless entitled to free school meals) this price includes, toast, cereal, milk & fruit juice.

In the event of closure due to adverse weather North Lanarkshire's website will be updated from 7am onwards. Where possible and practical we will send out a text to the first named contact to inform them of a school closure as soon as possible. We will also put out information regarding any closure on our Facebook page. Please be aware that sometimes Management staff are also stuck/walking en route to school which can cause unavoidable delays to communication.

Should there be issues with the bus companies service they will in the first instance contact the school to inform us and we will then let those affected know.

Please check the school website for a list of activities and learning opportunities the children can complete during the closure. If you feel that it is unsafe for your child to travel to school during significant snowfalls please contact us to inform us of your decision. Xpressions App

We send out text messages for absences/trips/events and general reminders. At the moment the school has to cover the cost of these messages. If <u>ALL</u> parents download the **Xpression App** from the app store we can send these out for <u>FREE</u>. We can also send attachments, like letters and Bulletins such as this, which would you can then check straight from your phone. The school require an up to date email address for you to download this, we will pick this up from the Annual Data Check form which you will have completed in August. If you wish to change your email address we hold for you please send in a letter to the school office.

REMINDERS

Absence - Please remember if your child is absent from school to call the office on the first day. Please do not email any member of staff as this may be missed if out of the building.

Sickness/Tummy Bugs – Children should not return until 48hours clear due to passing on the infection. **Gym Days** – **No** jewellery to be worn on gym days, all earrings must be taped up at home or removed prior to coming to school.

School Ties – Available from the school office - £4 each.

New Contact Details – If you have changed any contact details – Address/home/ mobile number or email, please pass this onto the school office. It is very important that we have up to date information in case of an emergency.

Afterschool Clubs – If your child attends a club and no longer wishes to attend or is missing a session please contact the school office, a register is taken for all the clubs run in school.

Bus children – If your child is not returning home on the school bus please inform the office or teacher by sending in a letter or phone call.
