Dear Parent/Guardian,

If your child will be unable to attend nursery for any reason please telephone the school on **01236 794828** to let us know. If you know in advance that your child will be absent for any reason please inform nursery staff.

Nursery sessions are 8.40 am until **11.50am** and 1pm until **4.10pm**. Please ensure your child is collected by these times as staff use the time after the children leave for planning and preparation.

### **Important information- Please Read**

- Can we ask that if you have entered the building through the school that no children are left unattended. The nursery staff will open the playroom door at 1pm at which point you can then safely leave your child in the care of the staff.
- If your child has been sick or has had an upset tummy they must be 48 hours clear of their last episode before returning to nursery this is to stop the spread of infection.
- Can you please ensure you take your child's shoes home at the end of their session. This ensures there will be no confusion as many of our children have the same indoor shoes.

## Health and Safety Important Information- Please Read

- Please help to ensure the safety of all children by allowing only those directly in your care to leave and always close the door firmly behind you by lifting the handle to ensure it is locked.
- Can we ask that if you have entered the building through the school that no children are left unattended. The nursery staff will open the playroom door at 1pm at which point you can then safely leave your child in the care of the staff.
- If you are in the cloakroom and the doorbell rings please alert a member of staff. Do not open the door
- Please ensure you sign your children in and out of the Nursery using the group sheets provided
- Please ensure that gates leaving the nursery and school grounds are closed to ensure the safety of both Nursery and School children. This has been brought to our attention again and is causing concerns as a number of parents are continuing to leave without closing gates.
- Please do not allow the children to open or close the gate.
- If your child has been sick or has had an upset tummy they must be 48 hours clear of their last episode before returning to nursery this is to stop the spread of infection.
