We are reading the books “Dragonfire” and “Carrie’s War”. Tell an adult what your book is about and as you read it weekly, write a summary of the chapters you have read by the end of each week.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Each night write your spelling words and a weekly spelling paragraph/interesting sentences.</p> <p align="center"><u>RME</u></p> <p>During the month of February we are thinking about temptations in preparation for lent – discuss ways of how to overcome these. Those of you receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation next month make sure you have chosen your Saint.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Numeracy/Maths</u></p> <p>Collect items, food or clothing labels or newspaper or magazine cuttings that involve percentages. Write the percentages as decimals and fractions.</p> <p>Solve the following puzzle: A farmer has 180 animals in a field. 1/5 are sheep, 25% are cows, 5% are horses and the rest are pigs. What percentage are pigs? How many of each animal?</p>	<p align="center"><u>Sumdog</u></p> <p>Use your Sumdog log in and challenge yourself to reach the next level. Try to play at least 30 minutes per week, remember the more you play at home the more coins you receive!</p>

Make a meal plan of breakfast, lunch and dinner for you and your family ensuring you are getting your 5-a-day.
