Use the phoneme and common word activities provided on the school website to help you learn.

Also try to do **IDL Literacy** for **10 minutes each day**, or 1 hour per week in total.

Maths

1. Continue to practise all your number stories to 10. Remember this means learning all the different ways to make 10.

$$0 + 10 = 10$$

$$1 + 9 = 10$$

$$2 + 8 = 10 \text{ etc}$$

Ask a grown up to test how **quickly** you can say your number stories to 10, for example by asking you:

$$" 3 + ? = 10 "$$

Time how quickly you can answer all your number stories to 10 correctly.

2. Practise your 2 times table and 5 times table.
3. Explain to a grown up what **dividing** means and try to answer some simple dividing questions eg 12 divided by 3.
4. Complete activities on **Sumdog** and **IDL Maths** as much as you can.

Note: these are suggested activities only. Any activities should only take a few minutes each day to help reinforce learning.
