Estimate, compare and describe other angles in relation to a right angle.

Ideas of Chance and Uncertainty

Developing an understanding of the following vocabulary;

***Might happen, might not happen* e.g. when discussing the weather, rolling a dice.**

Certain, possible, probable, unlikely, impossible

The children will predict the outcome of a range of scenarios such as; 'If you select a marble from a bag of 10 red marbles what is the probability of it being blue?'

The children will be learning :

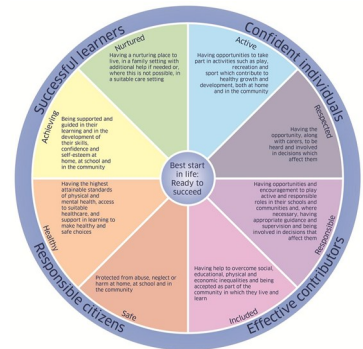
-That eating together is an important time to interact with others .
