- **Classifying ideas and words, using prior knowledge.**

- **To be able to think about questions and problem solve their meaning.**

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Numeracy and Maths



Our focus for this term will be:

Time

- **Revising half past and quarter past and quarter to.**
- **Telling the time to 5 minute intervals.**

All children will be learning to calculate simple time intervals by counting on to find the duration of events.

Number



- **Rounding numbers to the nearest 10/100**
- **Read, write and count numbers up to 1000**
- **Sequence numbers up to 1000**
- **Reading numbers to 1000 to include 1 decimal place**
- **Use function machines to solve simple numerical problems**
- **Create number statements using symbols for $<$, $>$ = and not equal to**



Mental Agility

- **Addition and subtraction facts to 20**
- **Sums and differences of multiples of 10 to 1000**
- **Addition doubles for multiples of 10 within 1000**

Focus for Learning

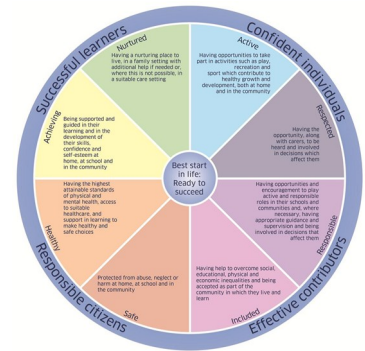
August– October P4
