In our school we will ensure all our children feel safe and nurtured and that everything we do reflects our Catholic values. We will continue to work towards Rights Respecting Award and encourage all connected with our school to be respectful of others.

We will improve Health and Wellbeing outcomes of our young people through the development of Emotional Literacy. Children will be better able to discuss their emotions, understand what makes them feel this way, how their body reacts and how they can manage their emotions. We will use Emotion Works throughout the school and nursery to facilitate this. We will share videos with parents to help them discuss emotional literacy at home.



In our nursery we will be more responsive to children's interests. We will ensure our planning takes account of their interests to better develop their learning. We will ensure we track children's learning effectively so that we are able to provide them with their next steps.

We will improve attainment in numeracy by making sure we provide rich, learning experiences. We will use questioning appropriately to judge a child's understanding of their learning and we will provide effective feedbacks that pupils will progress in their learning. We will use resources like Number Talks and Making Thinking Visible to support children in their learning.
