<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Reading</u></b></p> <p><b>Challenge</b> yourself – see how many books you can read during the month of September!</p> <p>This month our modelling block reading focus in class is on the novel “<b>Divided City</b>” – explain what the book is about and the key themes that we have been exploring in class.</p> <p><b>Home Reader</b> books provided.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Spelling</u></b></p> <p>In addition to daily spelling, write your 10 interesting sentences or a paragraph with your spelling words. <i>(Your child will write down their spelling words every Monday for the week ahead, please remind them to bring in their homework jotters to do this.)</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>RME</u></b></p> <p>During the month of <b>September</b> we are exploring the debate between <b>God’s Creation</b> and <b>Science</b>. Write a paragraph explaining how you think the <b>world began</b>.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Numeracy/Maths</u></b></p> <p>Practise <b>addition</b> and <b>subtraction</b> sums using <b>mental</b> and <b>written</b> strategies.</p> <p>Write them down, get a family member to quiz, or you can find and play equation games on a tablet or computer.</p> <p>Investigate the <b>importance of Maths in the real world</b> and <b>inventions</b>. Can you write down anything about <b>famous Scottish Mathematicians</b> and the impact they have made?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Sumdog</u></b></p> <p>Use your Sumdog log in and challenge yourself to reach the next level. Write down anything you notice outside on your walk.</p> <p>Can you <b>create a game</b> which involves simple <b>rules</b> for your classmates to <b>play</b> in gym?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Expressive Arts</u></b></p> <p>Can you design an <b>Autumn</b> inspired <b>illusion</b> using the <b>visual elements line</b> and <b>colour</b>.</p> <p>Research the <b>songs/music</b> that was played during the WWII (1939-1945) – can you learn any?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>HWB</u></b></p> <p>Discuss what a <b>risk assessment</b> is.
