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| <p>★ In October we will be learning the sounds ay- play ea – Leaf ow - snow</p> <p>Search through magazines/ books for words containing these sounds. Record them in your jotter and circle the sounds. Lists can be added to over the weeks.</p> | <p>★ Practise number bonds within 10 and 20. 4 and what makes 10? 16 and what makes 20? etc.</p> | <p>★ Take on some responsibility within your home. This could be making your bed, washing the dishes, feeding a pet. Let us know how you got on.</p> | <p>In October we will be thinking about Autumn and Halloween and we will be linking our science and outdoor learning into these areas.</p> |
| <p>★ We have revised stage 1 words. Children should continue to practise reading them and spelling the words aloud and in writing. Learn the following words: day away always today each year ask eat yellow grow again food</p> | <p>★ Numbers focus: 0-30 Suggestions include: Can you write the numbers 0-30? Check for correct formation and order. What numbers comes before/ after..? What number comes in between? Start at any number (say 14) and count forward/ backwards.</p> | <p>We will be doing Relax Kids on a Wednesday Afternoon. We have several cushions in class but if your child would like to bring their own they can. (Relax Kids is a programme to help children become resilient and help them develop tools and techniques to manage their emotional and mental health.)</p> | <p>In October we will have a focus on Art. We will be thinking about colours. Children will learn about primary, secondary, complementary colours and shades. Talk about some of the ways colours can be helpful and how they can be used. Look at colours in your world.</p> |
| <p>Once you are confident and reading your book fluently, try to become an expressive story teller by adding expression where relevant. <u>Return reading book and bag to school daily.</u></p> | <p>Learn the rhyme 30 days has September, April, June and November All the rest have 31 except February, which has 28 days clear and 29 each leap year.</p> | <p>Encourage good waiting, listening and turn taking in conversations with adults and other children.</p> | <p>We will have a focus on food exploring seasonal root vegetables. Talk about the ones you like and the dishes you would have them with. Research root vegetables native to Scotland.</p> |
