<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Non-Fiction: Read an article from a newspaper or online and AFTER reading, write 4 quiz questions about the article.</p> <p>See if your family member can answer them.</p> <p>This month our reading focus in class is on graphic novels – explain what a graphic novel is and create your own comic strip/book?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>In addition to daily spelling, write your 10 interesting sentences or a paragraph with your spelling words.</p> <p><i>(Your child will write down their spelling words every Monday for the week ahead, please remind them to bring in their homework jotters to do this.)</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>RME</u></p> <p>During the month of November we remember our loved ones who have died. Say a prayer in memory of a loved one you have lost.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Numeracy/Maths</u></p> <p>List the various different ways you can pay for goods. Explain what the terms profit and loss mean.</p> <p>Create a timetable of your day including breakfast, lunch, dinner, school, afterschool activities and bed time – time durations are important.</p> <p>Practise your 6, 7, 8, 9 times tables.
