<p align="center"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Challenge yourself – see how many books you can read during the month of October!</p> <p>This month we continue reading our group novels – summarise what the book is about, the key themes that we have been exploring in class and discuss the main characters.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>In addition to daily spelling, write your 10 interesting sentences or a paragraph with your spelling words. <i>(Your child will write down their spelling words every Monday for the week ahead, please remind them to bring in their homework jotters to do this.)</i></p> <p align="center"><u>RME</u></p> <p>During the month of October we are learning about the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Write a list of the gifts and explain what each gift offers you as a human being.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Numeracy/Maths</u></p> <p>Practise addition and subtraction sums using money examples. Write them down, get a family member to quiz, or you can find and play equation games on a tablet or computer. Can you find out more about other currencies?</p> <p>Write the following times in 12 hour and 24 hour notation: 3 o'clock in the morning Half past 6 in the afternoon Quarter past 8 in the evening Midday and Midnight</p>	<p align="center"><u>Sumdog</u></p> <p>Use your Sumdog log in and challenge yourself to reach the next level. Remember to explain rules clearly.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Expressive Arts</u></p> <p>Research artwork called "Illumination Art" carried out in the middle ages.
