Share with someone at home what yours are and try your best to stick to them.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Numeracy/Maths</u></b></p> <p>What are <b>multiples</b>?<br/>What are <b>factors</b>?<br/>List all the multiples of 8 up to 80.<br/>List all the factors of 72.</p> <p>What are <b>prime numbers</b>?<br/>Write out all the prime numbers from 1-100.</p> <p>What are <b>squared numbers</b>?<br/>Is 25 a square number?</p> <p>Research what the <b>Fibonacci number sequence</b> is.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Sumdog</u></b></p> <p>Use your Sumdog log in and challenge yourself to reach the next level. Try to play at least 30 minutes per week, remember the more you play at home the more coins you receive!</p> <p>Take part in the <b>multiplication tables challenges</b> to help develop your mental agility!</p>   |

Bring facts you have found in to share with the class.</p> <p>Key Questions to consider:<br/>Where is it?<br/>When was it built?<br/>What takes place there?</p>   | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Physical Activity</u></b></p> <p>If possible, <b>walk to school</b> as much as you can and do <b>15 minutes of exercise</b> at home before going to bed at night – stay off technology and get some fresh air!</p>  | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Expressive Arts</u></b></p> <p>Can you design a new <b>Scottish tartan</b>? See what <b>materials</b> you have lying around your home to see what you can come up with.
