Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use your common words to write a silly story - Spend ten minutes on IDL spelling programme (IDLS Group) - Spend ten minutes reading to an adult. Choose a book or magazine of your choice or log into Get Epic. - Write out your common words in 'Fancy Spelling' - Write a summary of your favourite book or movie - Write a set of instructions for something of your choice - Read a non-fiction book and write 6 facts about something you like (use a real book or Get Epic)
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Spend 10-15 mins on Sumdog - Use Topmarks website to play maths games linked to what you are learning in class - Practise your 8 & 9 times tables - Ask if your family have a measuring tape or ruler. Choose ten objects around your house or garden and measure them. Write the lengths down. - If you have food or bathroom scales, find 10 objects and write their weights in g or kg
Cross Curricular	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Draw or paint an Autumn picture with appropriate colours for the season - Draw a design for a Halloween costume. Label and colour it. Make a list of the materials you would need to make it for real. - Go for an Autumn walk. Collect things like nuts, berries, leaves, conkers and fir cones. Bring them home and make a little Autumn display. Take a picture and email to me on Glow. - All pupils have their glow login details on a card to take home. Spend some time finding your way around glow and try to download Microsoft Teams if you haven't already. These are important learning tools. - Fitness burst – try each of these for 30 second: squats, lunges, sit ups, push ups, explosive jumping jacks, forward kicks and side kicks. - Cook an autumn snack or meal.
