Complete the Christmas Counting and Addition to 10 activity sheets (attached to post). Remember to practise your number formation from 0-10 to make sure your numbers are written the right way!	We are talking a lot about our feeling and emotions this month. Create an emoji do describe how you feel. Tell someone a description of your emoji and why you have chosen it.	Learn your Christmas show songs: 1) Little Donkey 2) It was on a Starry Night 3) Away in a Manger 4) We Wish You a Merry Christmas (Link to each song next page).
Can you tell an adult a story about something you did at school this week? Who was with you? When did it happen? How did you feel? Draw a picture of your story.	Log on to Sumdog (login on Work from Home Jotter) and play 15-30 minutes per week. Certificate now awarded on a weekly basis for pupil who plays Sumdog the most each week.	Go for a festive walk and try to count as many Christmas trees as you can. If you go after sunset, you might get to see everyone's Christmas lights too!	Help an adult with wrapping their Christmas presents. Copy names onto the gift tags of presents. Sing a Christmas carol to someone to spread Christmas cheer.
