Clothing

Sessions

A polite request, could we please ask that you adhere to the session times 8.50am to 2.50pm, unless staff are aware that you collect out with these times. When parents/carers arrive at the gates unexpectedly out with session times it can cause disruption to the children who are already engaged in play within the playroom. Staff are having to leave learning experiences to come to the gate, which is disrupting children's learning. Children should be collected no later than 2.50pm. If you require to collect or drop off your child outside these times could you please let staff know by phoning or at the gate. Thank you.

Tigers and Frogs

The children in these groups have been enjoying learning about people who help us in particular doctors and nurses. They have been pretend playing through dressing up, looking after the dolls and peers who are sick, watching videos and looking at books about people who help us.

They have also been participating in sensory play making playdough with different smells, playing with shaving foam and sensory books and toys. They have also been learning about their families through discussions about who cares for you and finding out not everyone has the same type of family as them.

Outdoors they have been learning about up and down whilst they observe their environment. They are enjoying sensory play outdoors too through digging in the soil, water play and exploring bubbles.

Ladybirds and Dolphins

The children in these groups are really enjoying sensory play, they have been exploring water play with bubbles and pom poms. They have explored playdough with different smells and colours. The children have also been enjoying playing with transport and making garages or ramps from the blocks.

Outdoors they have been enjoying playing with the scooters and cars. A few of the children particularly like exploring the mud kitchen where we have been invited to try apple pies and soup. Some children liked making a little den from the tarpaulin and crates.
